By refining your Observation skills, Training skills and Performance skills

-*Observation skills:* Spot what doesn't work for you and change it

-*Training skills:* Hone in on working at a distance with duration and distractions.

Smarten up your shaping and capturing skills: Form and change behaviour sequences smoothly.

-*Refining your own Performance Skills:* Work on elegance, Finesse, Flow, Individuality and Panache!

Heelwork should be captivating!

Effective cuing: Fading the lure and make your cues discreet

Props: Make them fit into your performance with style and ease!

***Don't forget to bring a short piece of music*** (up to 1 minute duration) and a simple prop you would like to work on Please make sure your name and your dog's name are on the music.
